Week 1 – Belief Before Breakthrough

New Year, New Inner Script

Bible Texts: Romans 12:1-2; Mark 9:23-24 (ESV)

This Week's Actions

Declaration

In Jesus, I am not stuck in my old story. God is renewing my mind and rewriting my inner script.

Seed (Daily Rhythm)

Each morning, pray out loud: “God, I present my mind and my day to You. Renew my thinking today.”

Step (One Concrete Action)

Sometime this week, write down one limiting belief you carry about yourself, God, or your future. Next to it, write a Scripture truth that contradicts that belief and read the truth out loud three times.

Week 2 – Small Seeds, Big Harvest

Prosperity in Seed Form

Bible Texts: Galatians 6:7–9; Psalm 1:1–3 (ESV)

This Week's Actions

Declaration

I am planting small, faithful seeds with God this year, and He is in charge of the harvest.

Seed (Daily Rhythm)

Choose one rooted moment with God each day—about five minutes with Scripture and honest prayer. Pray: “Lord, plant me by Your streams today.”

Step (One Concrete Action)

Write down three small seeds for this week: one for your spirit (faith), one for your work or calling, and one for your relationships or money. With God's help, actually do them, even if they feel tiny.

Week 3 – Work That Worships

Faith in Your Workweek

Bible Texts: Colossians 3:23–24; 1 Corinthians 10:31 (ESV)

This Week's Actions

Declaration

My work is part of my worship. I serve Jesus in how I show up, not just in what I get paid.

Seed (Daily Rhythm)

Before work each day, pray: “Jesus, I’m doing this with You and for You. Help me honor You in my work today.”

Step (One Concrete Action)

Choose one specific situation at work—one relationship, recurring task, or meeting—and decide how you’ll do it differently this week because you’re doing it for God’s glory.

Week 4 – Stewardship & Overflow

Trusting God with What You Have

Bible Texts: Proverbs 11:24–25; Matthew 6:19–21, 24; Philippians 4:19 (ESV)

This Week's Actions

Declaration

I am a steward, not an owner. God is my Provider, and I choose to hold money with open hands.

Seed (Daily Rhythm)

Once a day, pray: “Lord, teach me to trust You with my money today and to use what I have to bless others.”

Step (One Concrete Action)

Sit with your real numbers—budget, bank app, or notebook—and take one practical step: either create a simple budget with God, or review your current one and choose one small, intentional act of generosity for this week.
